SIX MONTHS IN MEXICO.

CHAPTER I.

Voyage.—Jamaica.—Campeachy.—Orizaba.—St. Juan de Ullua.—Isla de Sacrificios.

ON the 11th of December, 1822, I sailed from Portsmouth in the Rawlings, a fine merchant vessel, of three hundred and fifty tons, twelve guns, and a crew of twenty men, commanded by Captain James Quelch. It was chartered to carry out a cargo of manufactured articles of Germany, on account of the Rhenish Company of Merchants, then about to establish themselves in Mexico.
