Whose music is the gladness of the world."

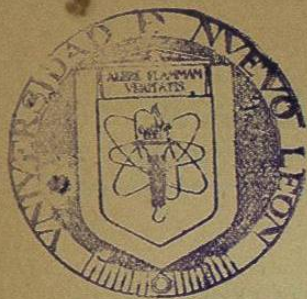
