En estos dibujos se refleja claramente el acondicionamiento de los niños a sus futuros papeles en la familia:

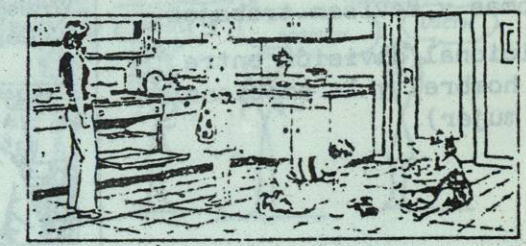

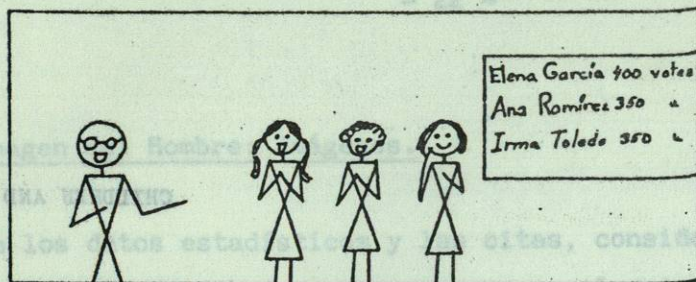

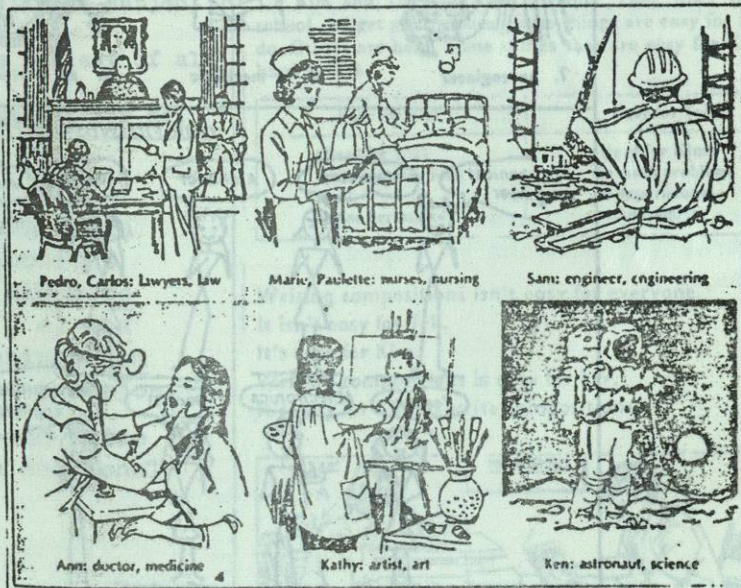
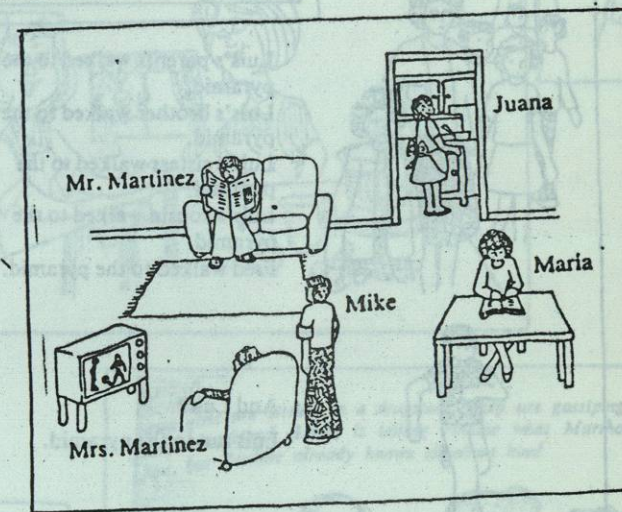
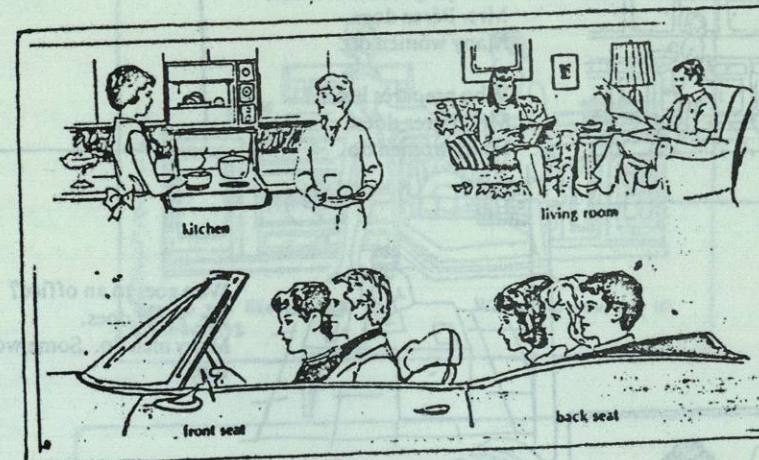


IMAGE OF THE FAMILY
