Astrology, the ancient art or science of divining the fate and future of human beings, is given by the positions of the stars (sun, moon and planets). The belief in a connexion between the heavenly bodies and the life of man are playing an important part in human history. Astronomy and astrology are identical and a distinction is made between "natural astrology" which predicts the motions of the heavenly bodies, eclipses, and "judicial astrology", which studies the influence of the stars of human destiny.

Isidore of Seville is one of the first to distinguish between astronomy and astrology.

In India and China astronomy and astrology are largely reflections of Greek theories and speculations; and similarly with the introduction of Greek culture into Egypt.
