Relative pronouns are WHO - WHICH - WHAT - THAT

WHO

"WHO" is used for persons.

Mr. Kromer is the teacher who wants to know everyone.

Emma Godoy, who is a mexican writer, lives in México.

WHICH

"WHICH" is used only of things.

The current, wich is very rapid, makes the river dangerous.

The animal, wich is here, is a raccon.

WHAT

"WHAT" is used When the antecedent is not expressed.

Tell me what want to know.

That's what I asked for.

THAT

"THAT" is invariable and is used for persons or things.

Shakespeare is the poet that England always remembers.

The game that they play is football.

WHEN

"WHEN" is used to introduce a relative clause which refers to a point of time. It is used in the same way as "WHEN" in the following examples.

WHERE

"WHERE" is used to introduce a relative clause which refers to a place. It is used in the same way as "WHERE" in the following examples.

WHY

"WHY" is used to introduce a relative clause which refers to a reason. It is used in the same way as "WHY" in the following examples.

HOW

"HOW" is used to introduce a relative clause which refers to a manner or degree. It is used in the same way as "HOW" in the following examples.
