We speak of the O HI' O River, the VIR GIN' IA House of Burgesses, the MIS SQ' RI Compromise; but we do not say the O HI' O AN River, the VIR GIN' IAN House, nor the MIS SQ' RI AN Compromise. An O HI' O AN, a VIR GIN' IAN, a MIS SQ' RI AN, and a CAL I FOR' NI AN, met the TEN NES SEE' AN on the MIS SIS SIP' PI River.
