1° *Denoting quality:* LIKE-LY-ABLE, IBLE-ISH-LESS-FUL-SOME-Y-ING-ED.

2° *Denoting material:* EN.

3° *Denoting number:* TEEN-TH-TY-FOLD.

4° *Denoting place or direction:* ERN-ERLY-WARD.

III. Of verbs:

1° *Denoting to make:* EN-SE-ISH.

2° *Forming frequentative, or words denoting the repetition of an act, and hence a habit or occupation:* LE-L, ER-ON-OM, M.

IV. Of adverbs:

1° *Denoting manner:* LY-WISE-LONG.

2° *Denoting time:* CE-TIMES.

3° *Denoting place:* WARDS-WARD. NCE-THER.

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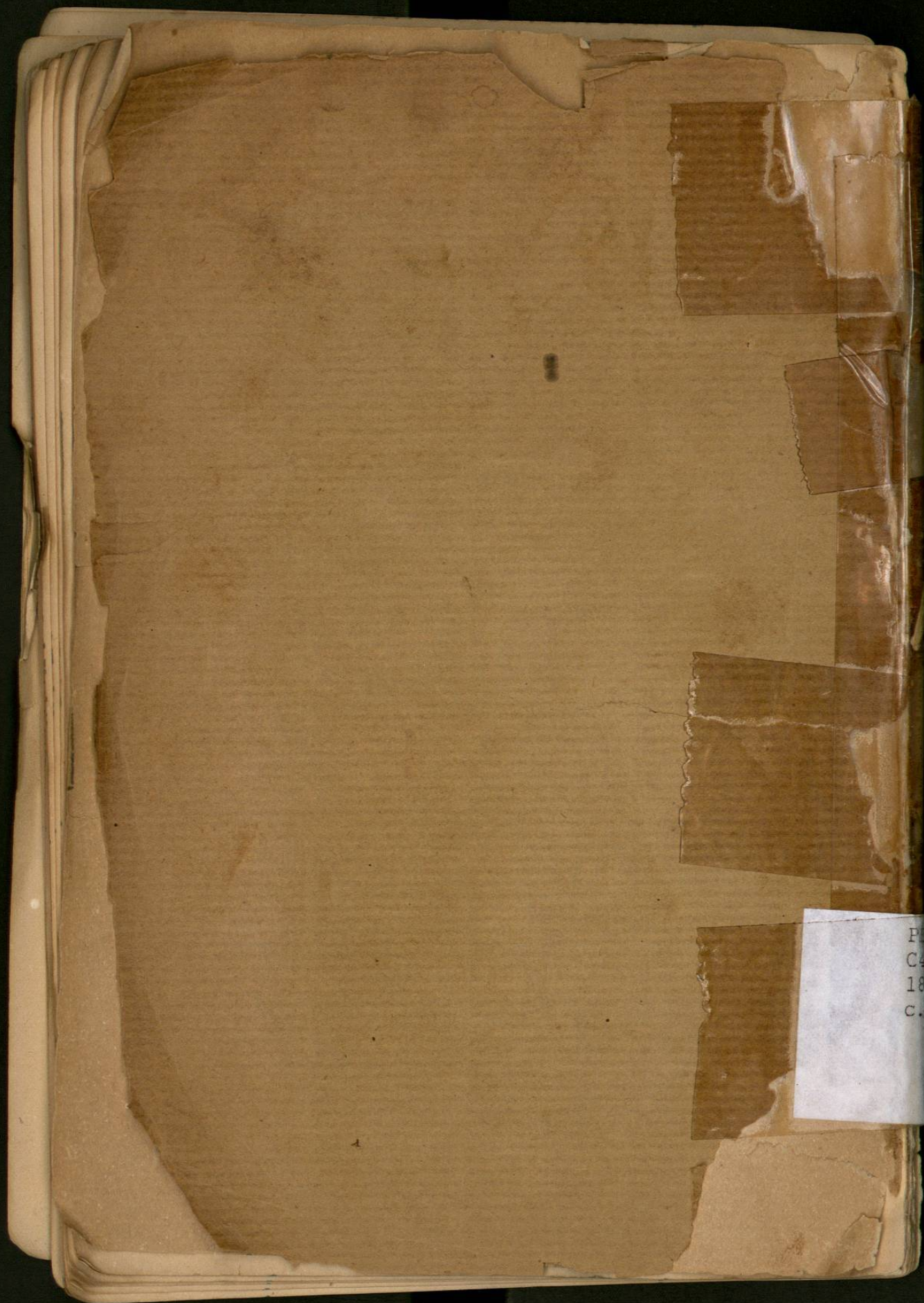
