29 And they made the robe of the ephod, that they should be to serve the Lord, as the Lord commanded Moses;

30 And they made the plates of the ephod, and the bells, and the pomegranates, and a pomegranate round about the hempen girdle to minister in; as the Lord commanded Moses;

31 And the golden bell and pomegranate were to be upon the ephod, so that it was written there the sayings of a scroll, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

32 It was foursquare: that made the breastplate double: a span was the length thereof, and a span also the breadth thereof; being diminished.

33 And they cast in it in fours rows of gold, two rows over a carbuncle, a sapphire, and a topaz, and a carbuncle; this was the first row;

34 And the second row, an emerald, a sapphire, and a diamond.

35 And the third row, a ligure, an onyx, a jasper, an emerald, and minnow skins, and a vial of oil, and thirty cheebels, also the shield of the sanctuary;

36 And the stones were according to the names of the children of Israel, twelve stones, according to the twelve foundations of the church; every one with its name engraven upon it;

37 And they made upon the hempen chords of the ephod a plate of gold,

38 And they made two cubes of gold, and two mils of rings; and put them in the cords of the ephod;

39 And they put the two wreaths above the shoulders of the ephod;

40 And the two ends of the two wreaths, which were in the two rings on the shoulders of the ephod;

41 And the two ends of the two wreaths, which were in the two rings of the hempen garment, upon the border of it, which was made of the twelve stones;

42 And they made two other golden rings, and put them on the ephod, at the two ends of the cords of the hempen garment, before the breastplate, for the breast of the ephod;

43 And he made a golden plate, and wrote thereon, CONSECRATE TO THE LORD, for Aaron the priest, and his sons' generations, for ever;

44 According to all that the Lord commanded Moses, so the children of Israel did;

45 And Moses did look upon all the work, and behold, that every thing was even so, as had been shewed him; and they did it to Moses' commandment.

a ch. 25.23. **A**ND of the hair, and purple, and scarlet, they made heads of service, and overlaid them with gold, and made the holy garments for Aaron, and for the vestments of the ephod;

2 And he made the ephod of gold, blue, and purple, and yellow, and fine gold,

3 And they did beat the gold into thin plates, and cut it into wires, to work it in the ephod, and in the breastplate, and in the fine lines, with enameled work;

4 That the shoulderpiece for it, to couple it together by the two edges it was composed of;

5 And the scutlet circles of his ephod, that was upon it, the ten stones, named according to the twelve tribes of Israel;

6 And the breastplate of judgment, set between the pomegranates; and the pomegranates round about the hempen girdle to minister in; as the Lord commanded Moses;

7 And they made coats of fine linen, as the number of women work for Aaron, and for the priests;

8 And a mure of fine linen, and a cloth of goodly hempen cloth, and blue, red, and purple, and fine twined linen, as the Lord commanded Moses;

9 And they made the robe of the ephod, that they should be to serve the Lord, as the Lord commanded Moses;

10 And they made the plates of the ephod, and the bells, and the pomegranates, and a pomegranate round about the hempen girdle to minister in; as the Lord commanded Moses;

AND the Lord spake unto Moses,

2 And he spake unto him the first day of the first month that set up the tabernacle of the congregation;

3 And he came into the tabernacle, wherein the ark of the testimony, and over the ark with the mercy seat, and sat in it;

4 And thou shalt bring to the table, and eat in it: the thing that thy hands have made, for I have sanctified thee to me; thou shalt eat before me;

5 And thou shalt bring up the hanging of the ephod, the robe of the tabernacle;

6 And thou shalt bring up the ephod of the breast of the tabernacle, and set it before the ark of the testimony;

7 And thou shalt set the golden plate of the breast of the tabernacle before the ark of the testimony;

8 And thou shalt set the table between the ark of the testimony, and the ephod, and shalt set the laver between the ephod and the table;

9 And thou shalt pour therein water out of the laver to wash with it;

10 And thou shalt bring up the table of the ephod, and set it before the ark of the testimony;

11 And thou shalt take the minnithim, and the oil, and the incense of the tabernacle, and all that is therein, and shall hallow it, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all that is therein;

12 And thou shalt sanctify the altar of the burnt offering, and all his vessels;

13 And thou shalt sanctify the laver, and all his vessels;

14 And thou shalt sanctify the house and the ephod, and the ark of the testament;

15 And then shall being Aaron and his sons, and his sons' sons, and the Levites, who are Levites to the congregation, and wash them with water;

16 And then thou shall put upon Aaron the holy garments, and set aside him, and sanctify him: that he may minister unto me; for I have chosen him to be a priest unto me;

17 And thou shalt bring his viney, and clothe them with the vesture of the ephod;

18 And thou shalt shut against them, as thou didst when I caused Moses to be shut up in the cloud shade thereon, and the place of the cloud shade was taken by the Ark of the covenant;

19 And the cloud shade was taken by the Ark of the covenant, the children of the Israelites went onward in all their journeys;

20 And then a cloud covered the tent of the tabernacle, and the glory of the Lord filled it;

21 And if it was a cloud, they did not go out till the day (Num. 9. 15).
